If you are an applicant to the University of Toronto's medical school for the graduate applicant and/or MD/PhD stream, you must submit an academic CV as part of your OMSAS application. **Applications to these streams will be considered incomplete without the submission of your CV by the October 1, 2016, deadline.**

Note: Applicants completing a course-based Master's program are not required to submit an academic CV as part of the OMSAS application.

- Do not substitute or add headings of your own. If you do so, they will not be evaluated.
- Under each heading, list activities/events/items in a chronological order.
- **Please do not include non-academic and/or extracurricular activities**, as you will be listing these activities as part of the Autobiographical Sketch and, if applicable, Brief Personal Essay components.
