

# ACADEMIC CURRICULUM VITAE (CV) INSTRUCTIONS

All **MD/PhD applicants (undergraduate and graduate)** must submit an academic CV as part of your OMSAS application.

All **graduate applicants** from a research-based program must submit an academic CV as part of your OMSAS application.

Applicants completing a **course-based Master's program** are not required to submit an academic CV as part of the OMSAS application when applying to the MD program, but must submit an academic CV for applications to the MD/PhD program.

**Applications to these streams will be considered incomplete without the submission of your CV.** The SAM tool can take two business days to be activated after your initial MD application submission. The deadline for receiving the academic CV is **October 6, 2017**.

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## CV Format

- Use the headings provided below to prepare your CV.
- If a heading is not applicable to your experience, please do not use it.
- Do not substitute or add headings of your own. If you do so, they will not be evaluated.
- Under each heading, list activities/events/items in a chronological order.
- **Please do not include non-academic and/or extracurricular activities**, as you will be listing these activities as part of the Autobiographical Sketch and, if applicable, Brief Personal Essay components.
